OBITUARY Fredine Goodall, 1905 Carver Drive, passed away on Friday, September 11, 2009 at home. She was born September 28, 1929 to the union of Fred and Erieline Wynn in Montgomery, Alabama. She came to Muncie in 1943 at age 13 to live with her Uncle and Aunt Harvey and Edna Ligon after the death of both her mother and father which left six children orphans. She enrolled at McKinley Jr. High School and went on to Muncie Central High School, graduating with honors in 1947. She attended Ball State University for one year and dropped out to marry her high school sweetheart Hurley C. Goodall upon his return from service in the U.S. Army on May 1, 1948. They celebrated 60 years of marriage on May 1, 2008. Two sons were born to this union, Hurley Jr. in 1949 and Frederick in 1952. Fredine enrolled in the first LPN School at Ball Memorial Hospital and upon graduation she was employed at the hospital. She worked there until retirement after 31 years of employment, most of which was in pediatrics. A strong supporter of her husband Hurley's community endeavors, she traveled with him all over the country when he was elected to the Muncie Community Schools Board of Trustees from 1970 to 1978. When Hurley was elected to the Indiana House of Representatives in 1978, she again became very involved and supportive of his endeavors, and served as President of the Indiana General Assembly Wives Club in 1985 and 1986. Hurley was often asked, "How is Freddie?", before he was asked "How are you?", by Governors and others. She leaves to cherish her memory, her husband, Hurley Sr.; two sons; Hurley Jr.(wife:

Patricia), Akron, OH and Frederick (wife: Linda), St. Petersburg, FL; four sisters, Louise McDade, Detroit, MI, Loretta Robinson, Albany, NY, Jane Merrel, Bellevue, NE, Erielynn McDaniel, Albany, NY; eight grandchildren, Ashaki Goodall, Nataki Goodall and Kimberly Ofebike all of Washington, D.C., Hurley Goodall III, Washington, D.C.; Angela Goodall, Chicago, IL; Sondra Goodall, Carrie Goodall and Dondra Goodall all of St. Petersburg, FL; three great-grandchildren; and special friends, Sandra Bell, Patricia Fields, Viola Richardson and Mildred Jones.
