Rosella Thompson passed away peacefully after a brief illness on September 22, 2012 just four days shy of her 82nd birthday. She was born September 26, 1930 to the late Deacon Willie B. and Lillie Pearl Moore in Ryland, Alabama. She was one of four siblings, predeceased by her sister Henrietta Pickett and brother Shelby Moore. She was educated in the public schools of Huntsville.
